Empowering Women in Englewood: Breaking Barriers, Building Futures

Women in the workforce face many barriers to increasing their income that go beyond the gender wage gap. Many struggle to find affordable housing and childcare and lack the mentorship and financial coaching they need to be successful.

CFW launched Englewood Women's Initiative (EWI) in partnership with Teamwork Englewood in 2017 in recognition that creating a better future for women and families in Englewood requires a wrap-around approach that addresses all the other challenges women face.

"CFW wanted to figure out how it could be more supportive of work in Englewood," says Cecile De Mello, Executive Director, Teamwork Englewood. "After attending Englewood's Quality of Life Plan meetings, CFW really listened to what the community wanted and needed, and together we launched EWI."

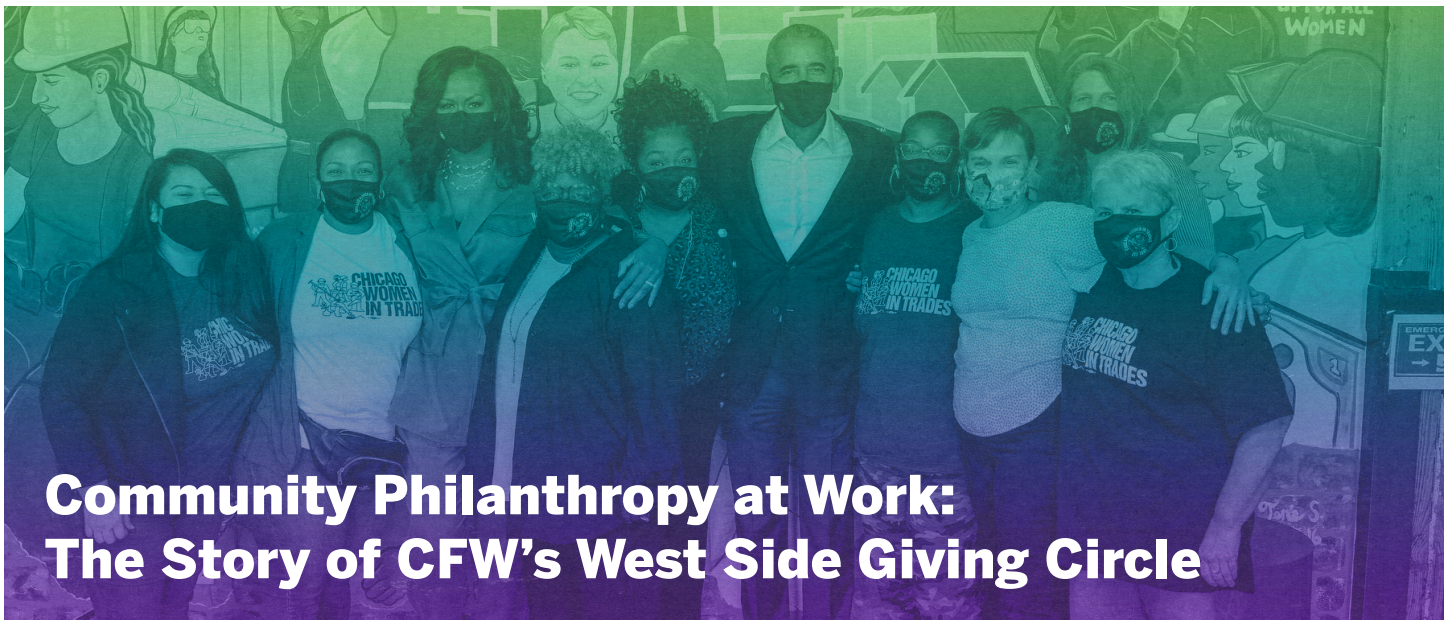
Women who join EWI have an average annual income of \$10,000. The goal is to increase their income to at least \$40,000 by providing them with career mentorship and training, as well as connecting them with other services through a network of community partners.

"CFW did research around how many heads of household in Englewood were women," comments Cecile. "They believed that investing in women's workforce development uplifts families and, ultimately, communities."



In 2021, during the fifth year of the program, the Englewood Women's Initiative evolved to address a new reality: many participants were out of work because their employers had shuttered during the pandemic. The EWI program became part of Teamwork Englewood's mutual aid network—connecting participants with rental assistance and other services. We also reconsidered how to offer "pandemic-resistant" workforce training in areas like IT that would support remote work.

"Through the network of partners that EWI brings together, we've been able to match 52 women with jobs and services they need—lifting them and their families out of poverty and empowering them to build a financially stable future for their families," Cecile says.



Community Philanthropy at Work: The Story of CFW's West Side Giving Circle

Traditional views of philanthropy suggest that only those who possess great wealth (often inherited) can participate. Giving back to the community, however, doesn't need to be an exclusive undertaking. In 2021, a group of women committed to empowering and strengthening West Side communities joined to form CFW's West Side Giving Circle.

Chartise Clark and Corliss Garner were among the founders. When Chartise relocated to the West Side of Chicago from Baltimore, she soon realized the potential that her new neighborhood had—as well as the problems that it faced. While there seemed to be an active community of nonprofits and philanthropy focused on bringing investment to the South Side of Chicago, Chartise noticed the West Side struggled to get the same attention.

Corliss became involved through a focus group on how to involve more women of color in philanthropy. Inspired by CFW's South Side Giving Circle (founded in 2018), which brings together women to pool collective funds in support of local initiatives, she knew she wanted to help create a Giving Circle on the West Side.

The two were connected by CFW, and as they began to form the West Side Circle, Advocate Bethany Community Health Fund came on board with an initial endowment to help support the work of the Giving Circle. The Circle was

officially launched in 2021, and Chartise and Corliss immediately set their sights on identifying members willing to contribute \$250 to join the group—a small amount compared to traditional philanthropy. They recruited 30 members.

"We hoped to make philanthropy more accessible while impacting women and girls on the West Side of Chicago," says Corliss.

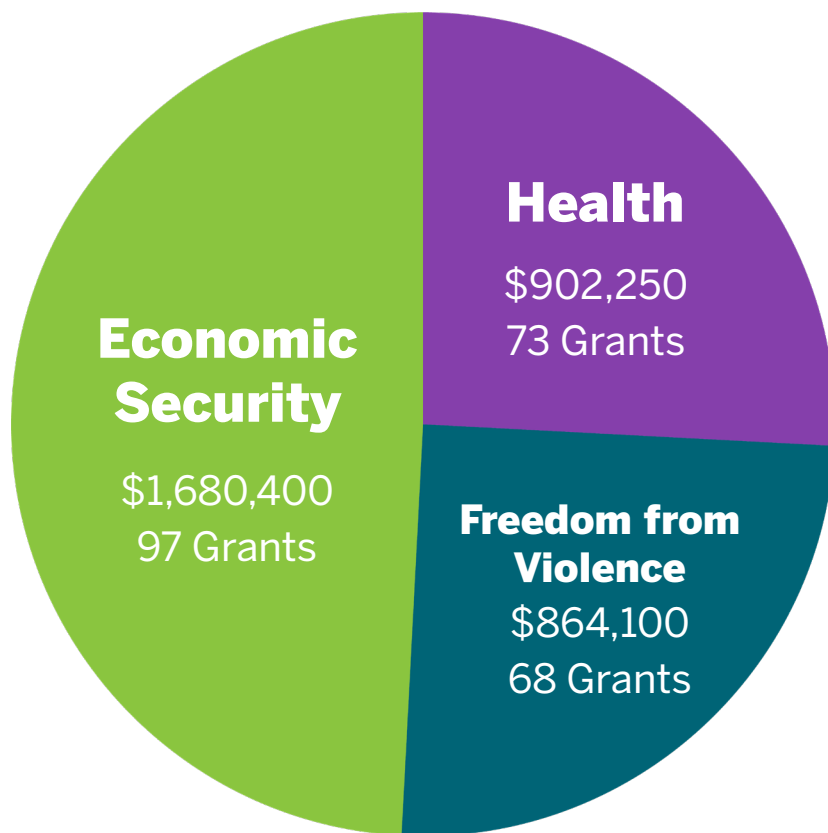
The next step was deciding which organizations to fund. In their first year, the Circle gave a total of \$20,000 to three organizations. Among them was Taproots Inc., an organization in Austin that operates a mentoring program for young girls around social and emotional learning. Grants also went to Project Exploration, which seeks to get more girls and minorities interested in STEM, and to Black Girls Break Bread, which advocates for better access to high-quality health care for Black women and girls.

According to Chartise, one of the best parts of creating the Circle was building a space where women who have a connection to the West Side can impact their own community and build a dialogue with their neighbors.

"It helps average people see themselves as philanthropists. Through the Circle, we have a group of women who have become collective voices for issues on the West Side," she says.

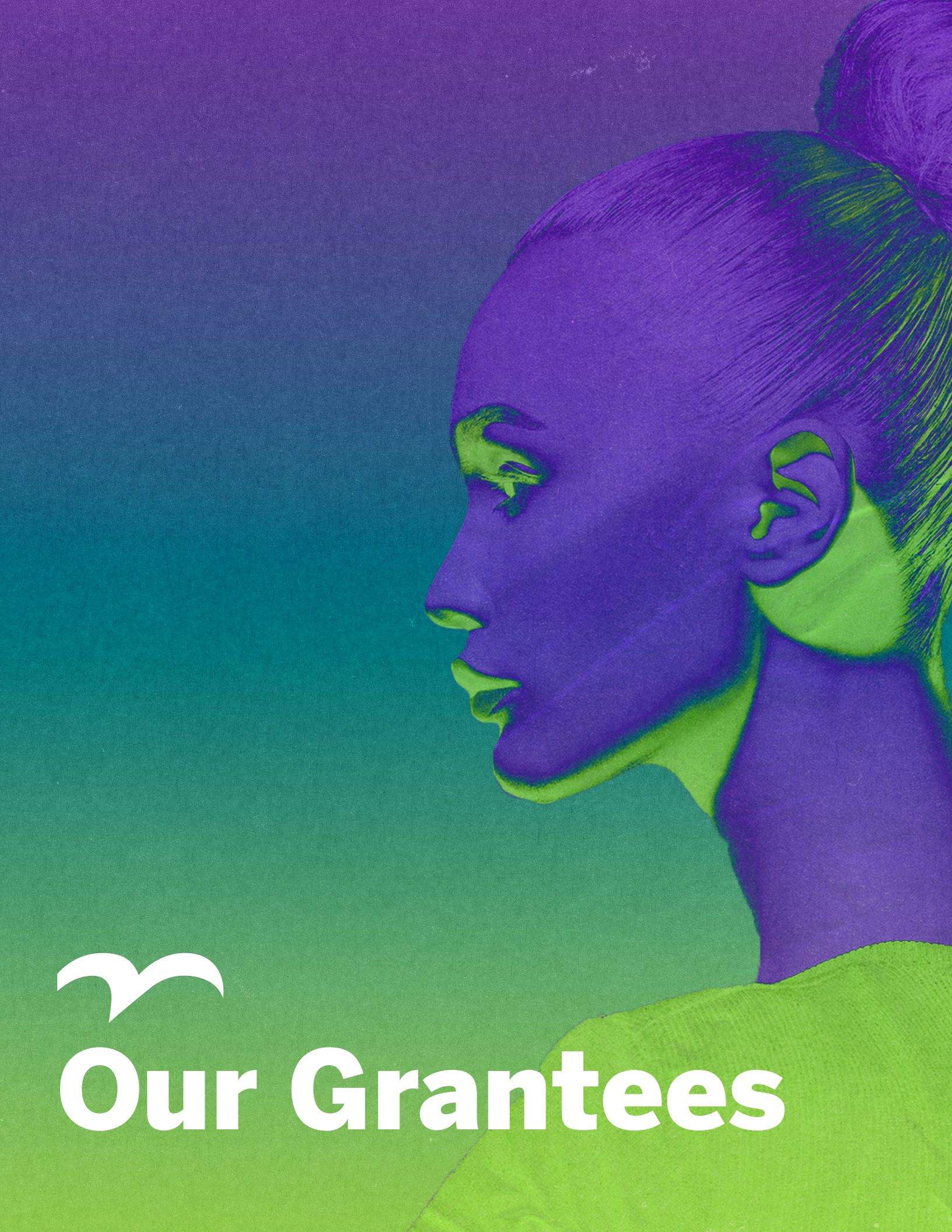
